Although I do feel like I actively participated in class discussions, I feel as though I could have more.



I think taking notes and going in for office hours was the biggest activities that helped me do well.




could have done more after classes

I took microeconomics in high school, so I set high goals for myself in this class. I did not reach these goals.


Sitting at a high B, doable.

She wanted us to know a lot more than what she was teaching I felt, and do a lot of outside work that might have been prevented if mentioned in class.



Plenty of group work chances.


Throughout the course we did do group projects and some activities in the class room wich I thought was very beneficial and fun!

There was a lot of group work.






